ICE SHOW All families are expected to assist in preparation for the annual ice show on Sunday, March 15. Each skater is responsible for the cost of renting or purchasing costumes and skin-tone tights when required. Cost of group costumes will be \$25-30 per number. Cost of solo and pairs costumes will be determined by those skaters.

SKATING FEES \$726.35 registration + 43.65 Skate Canada membership and insurance + \$30 Skate Canada Saskatchewan fee = **TOTAL \$800** *This does not include coaching fees, which are paid directly from skater to coach.

2019 STARSKATE COACHING AND COMMITMENTS

On the recommendation of Skate Canada, STARSkaters are now encouraged to participate in more small-group lessons and fewer private lessons. Coaches will determine groupings based on level and skill. Cost of group lessons will be divided equally among the number of skaters in a given group (ideally four or fewer per group). Coaches will send invoices out to families and families pay coaches directly. If an invoice remains unpaid after 14 days, the skater may not be permitted on the ice.

COMPETITION Skaters who choose to compete are responsible for all associated costs. Competitors are also responsible for covering the mileage and accommodation costs of the attending coach(es), divided equally by the number of skaters attending the competition.

TESTING Skaters who choose to test are responsible for all associated costs. Parent(s)/guardian(s) will be notified of costs closer to testing dates. Payments are made to the Test Chair by or before the day of the test. STARSkate families are expected to assist with test days where needed.

MOBILE PHONE USAGE Skate Humboldt values the health, privacy, and property of its members and their families. As such, dressing rooms have been designated PHONE-FREE ZONES. This restriction also includes any device capable of taking photographs or recording audio. Such devices may be used in any public area of the arena including hallways and penalty boxes. Skate Humboldt board members and coaches have the authority to warn any individual of prohibited device usage and instruct them to put the device away. Upon a skater's first warning, an email will be sent to their parent(s)/guardian(s). Upon second warning, the skater will be sent home immediately and will still be responsible to pay the cost of lessons missed that day. Phones and other devices must be stored out of sight and may not be charged in dressing rooms. All property left unattended is at the owner's risk.

I will model positive and responsible behavior in my words and actions. I will treat all individuals and property with dignity, courtesy, and respect.
