By choosing Text via Remind App you consent for Skate Humboldt to enter your information into the Remind service. The number you provide must be capable of sending and receiving SMS (text) messages. This service is not eligible to customers of Rogers or any of its subsidiaries.

The Junior STARSkate program is for CanSkaters in levels 5 and 6 who wish to commit to figure skating. As they are completing their final CanSkate levels while in the Junior program, skaters must continue to wear their CSA-approved helmets on the ice. Juniors enjoy a smaller group size with more coaching time. A portion of the Juniors lesson time will be at the same time as the CanSkate program.

SCHEDULE Juniors receive two 45-minute lessons per week, each **Monday and Friday** from 5:30 to 6:15 p.m., beginning October 18 and ending March 21.

FEES \$636.35 registration (includes coaching fees), \$43.65 Skate Canada membership (includes insurance) and \$30.00 Skate Canada Saskatchewan fee. **TOTAL \$710.00**

FAMILY DISCOUNT If you have three or more children enrolled in the CanSkate, Junior, and/or STARSkate program(s), you may deduct **\$100** for your third and further skaters. **Only a family's first two skaters pay full fees.*

NO REFUNDS except for complete cancellation due to injury or illness. Doctor's certificate must be submitted to receive a refund. Skate Canada membership (effective to August 31, 2022) and Skate Canada Saskatchewan fee are non-refundable. Cancelled classes are not refunded or rescheduled unless approved by the board.

SKATERS' LOTTERY Skate Canada Saskatchewan's annual lottery is a major fundraising source for skating clubs across the province.
